On July 1, 2018 we became one organization in pursuit of these guiding principles:



- ▶ **Utilize and maximize both organizations' partnerships and networks** for the benefit of Pikes Peak Region nonprofits and nonprofits across the state.
- ▶ **Maintain effective, impactful, locally-developed programs and services** with the addition of the Association's statewide and national resources and member benefits.
- ▶ **Engage Pikes Peak Region nonprofits in a statewide network** that works to create public awareness, public policies and partnerships that support a flourishing operating environment for nonprofits across the state.

In adding a second office for the Association in Colorado Springs, we welcomed three outstanding staff members and leaders in their community, and one new Board member previously serving on the CNE Board. This enriched capacity to lead and serve nonprofits has already proven to be a boon to meeting the needs of our members in the Pikes Peak region and across the state.

Created the Donate to a Colorado Nonprofit Fund



- ▶ **Led the effort to pass SB 18-141**

We successfully worked with the CO legislature to enact a first in the country "Donate to a Colorado Nonprofit Fund", which will **allow taxpayers to donate their state refund to any nonprofit** registered with the Secretary of State for at least five years and in good standing. The Fund essentially creates **a new system of charitable giving** and begins to take effect for the 2019 tax year, filing in 2020.

Launched the 4th Edition of Principles & Practices



- ▶ **Developed by Colorado nonprofits for Colorado nonprofits**, covering everything from completing the form 990 to best practices for fundraising, governance, technology and more.
- ▶ **New topic area on Diversity, Equity and Inclusion**
- ▶ **Over 30 new or expanded sections**
- ▶ **First edition to be offered in both Spanish and English**
- ▶ **2,000 print copies distributed** and **840 downloaded** through our website in 2018
